

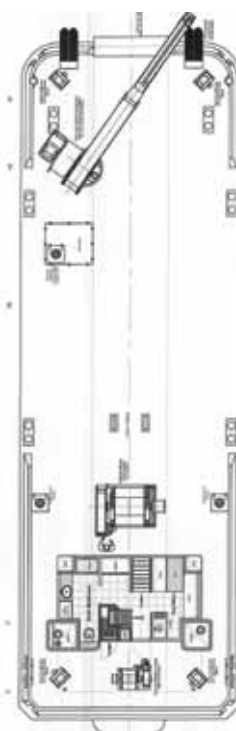


## Megan M
